India's first BSL IV lab upgraded as an Institute

The HSADL. Bhopal India's first BSLIV facility established in the year 1998 was functioning as a regional campus of IVRI, Izatnagar which is under the aegis of ICAR. Over the years, with the recurrent outbreak of Avian Influenza and increased threat posed by other newer animal diseases, the need for establishement of a national institute was felt to have diagnostic preparedness and to initiate basic and applied research on exotic and



emerging animal diseases. The ICAR has upgraded the laboratory to National Institute of High Security Animal Diseases (NIHSAD). A newer integrated BSL II + BSL IV facility is being proposed to be established.
